



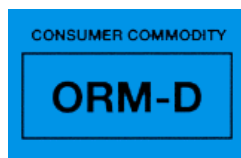
SABRE Recycling program – Completing the Green Cycle

Process:

Security Equipment Corporation (SEC) will accept all partially used and expired OC canisters from law enforcement agencies. SEC will empty the contents of the canisters using an U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) approved aerosol can puncture and disposal system. The contents will be disposed of according to EPA regulations on Hazardous Waste Disposal, thus preventing the contamination of our waterways. The canisters and the plastic flip tops will be recycled for use in future products. SEC's program to recycle aerosol defense sprays will help ensure the availability of the Earth's resources for future generations.

In order to participate in the program, law enforcement agencies must return their Aerosol Irritant Projectors to Security Equipment Corporation following these guidelines:

1. Agencies can return the number of cans equal to the number of SABRE canisters purchased. If another brand is being returned to SEC for recycling/disposal purposes, proof of SABRE purchase is required.
2. Agencies wishing to return more units than they are purchasing can do so for a fee. Please call SABRE at 1-800-325-9568 or e-mail Bob Nance at RNance@sabre-sabred.com for a price quote.
3. Package used and expired Aerosol Irritant Projectors in a Box labeled with the ORM-D Consumer Commodity logo. The easiest solution may be for you to send back the canisters within the box you received your SABRE canisters. The box containing your SABRE canisters will likely already contain the below image.



4. If an ORM-D Consumer Commodity box is not available, contact SABRE for a SABRE Recycling Return Box at 1-800-325-9568. Please have the size and number of cans available when calling. This information determines how many boxes are required.
