

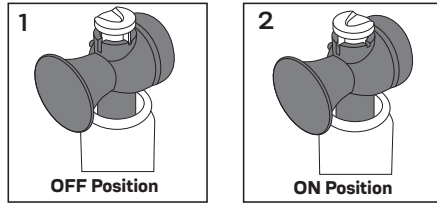
FRONTIERSMAN BEAR HORN MANUAL

What does the SABRE® FRONTIERSMAN Bear Horn do?

- Compact and easy to carry, the FRONTIERSMAN BEAR HORN helps deter bears by alerting them of your presence, so you do not startle them. Startling a bear can cause a bear to attack. The horn produces a powerful 130 dB blast audible up to ½ mile (804m) away. When in bear country, sound the horn every ½ mile (804m) to alert bears. Contains: Up to sixty (60) ¼ second bursts. Up to twenty-five (25) ½ second bursts.



How do I deploy my SABRE Bear Horn?

- To lock the button when not in use, rotate the button counter-clockwise into the notch marked "off". The button is now locked and will not accidentally deploy (see image 1).
- To unlock the horn, rotate the button located at the top of the horn clockwise, moving the indicator arrow towards the notch marked "on". The Horn is ready to sound (see image 2).

Instructions:

- For best results, deploy ¼ to ½ second bursts every ½ mile of terrain covered to alert bear of your presence.
- **ALWAYS HOLD CAN IN UPRIGHT POSITION. DO NOT SHAKE BEFORE OR DURING USE.**
- **USE ONLY SHORT BURSTS OR BEAR HORN WILL NOT WORK.**
- Ensure the horn is always hand tight to the canister for effective use.
- Removing the horn from the canister is NOT recommended.

⚠ WARNING

The FRONTIERSMAN BEAR HORN is **NOT** designed to deter bears that already see you, including bears that are charging or attacking. Prior to use you **MUST** read and follow the instructions for best results. Although this horn can be heard up to ½ mile (804m) away, Security Equipment Corporation **DOES NOT** guarantee this product will prevent a bear attack and **DOES NOT** guarantee this product can keep you safe in all scenarios.
