

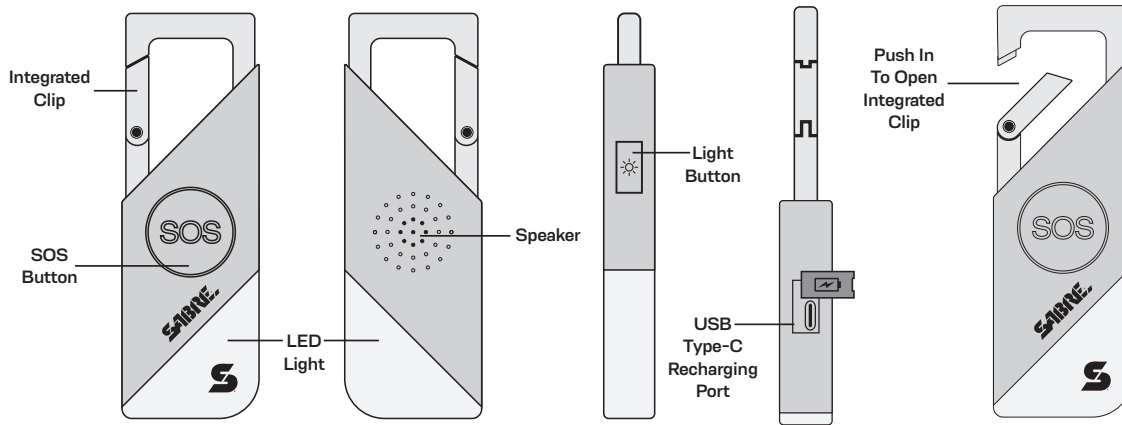

What does the SABRE® Personal Alarm do?

The compact design allows the Personal Safety Alarm to be discreetly carried on a key ring, purse, etc. The idea is to be prepared, so take the Personal Safety Alarm wherever you go. It is recommended the Personal Safety Alarm be carried when walking alone, entering buildings, hallways, elevators, parking lots, etc.



Directions

1. Press the SOS Button twice quickly to activate the alarm and LED strobe feature.
2. While alarm is sounding and LED strobe light is functioning, press the SOS Button once to deactivate.
3. To turn on LED light, press the Light Button on side.
4. To turn off LED light, press the Light Button on side.

Low Battery Indicator

It is recommended that the Personal Alarm be tested regularly to check battery life. This can be done by activating the SOS button or turning on the LED Light. When the battery level falls below 3.3V the Personal Alarm LED light will flash 3x and the unit will beep 3 times alerting you to charge the battery.

Charging Battery

NOTE: It is recommended that the battery be fully charged before first use.

1. Use the included USB Type-C cable to plug in the Personal Alarm to charge.
2. It takes about 70 minutes to charge the Personal Alarm fully.
3. While charging, a red light will be lit. When fully charged, the red light turns off.
4. It is recommended to charge once every 3 months.

Integrated Clip Use

Open the integrated clip and securely fasten it to a belt loop, bag strap, or other suitable attachment point. Ensure the clip is fully closed before use to keep the Personal Alarm properly secured.

NOTE: The integrated clip is constructed from plastic and is not designed to support substantial loads. Its intended function is limited to the attachment and detachment of the Personal Alarm device. Excessive force, pressure, or improper use may result in structural failure of the clip, which will void the product warranty.

- **NOT** suitable for children under 3 years, because small parts could be swallowed.
- Prolonged exposure to alarm siren may cause permanent hearing loss.
